The Pediatric-Adolescent Diabetes Research Education (PADRE) Foundation Scholarship Program is available to incoming freshmen seeking a higher education at an accredited four year university, college, technical or trade school. This scholarship recognizes students who are actively involved in the diabetes community, who have high academic performance, who participate in community and/or extra-curricular activities and who have demonstrated that they are successfully managing the challenges of living with Type 1 diabetes. The PADRE Foundation Scholarship Program is not based on financial need.

Scholarship Award:

The following scholarship will be awarded to students who are high school seniors and will be incoming freshmen in the fall of 2019, who have Type 1 diabetes:

- The PADRE Foundation Scholarship Program (scholarships from \$500-\$1,000) will be awarded to students that will be incoming freshmen with Type 1 diabetes.

Eligibility:

- High School Seniors with Type 1 diabetes seeking a higher education at an accredited four year university, community college, technical or trade school.
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident.

Application Process:

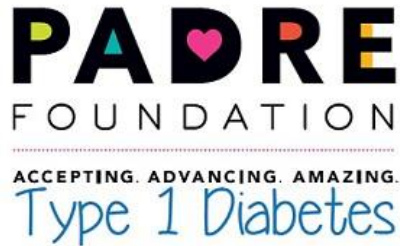
- Complete the application along with a Letter(s) of Recommendation
- Completed application must be received in PADRE office by April 4, 2019.

- Applicants will be notified via email when their application is received.

Selection Process:

- Completed applications will undergo a blind process and sent to a review committee for evaluation.
- Each application will be scored using a grading grid.
- A selection committee will meet to award the scholarships.

Award Announcements:

- The winners of the 2019 scholarships will be telephoned by Thursday, April 25th and will be recognized at our Saturday, May 11th Fashion Show held at the Hyatt Regency Huntington Beach Resort and Spa. Those applicants not selected will not receive any other notification.
- Checks will be distributed directly to the school in July once it's been verified that the recipients have been accepted and registered to an accredited four-year university, college, technical or trade school.
